TRAINING SEMINAR

12:30 - 1:30 SESSION 1

Explosive Hazard Recognition and Safety Awareness

This course is designed to help inform members of the Law Enforcement community of the growing threat of terrorism and explosive hazards. The class is heavily focused on officer safety and will cover: Threat to Transportation Systems, Explosive Effects, Improvised Explosive Devices (IEDs), IED Construction, Suicide Bombers, Vehicle Born Improvised Explosive Devices (VBIED), Ordnance Recognition, and Booby Traps.

Course objectives:

- 1. Understand the 3 basic effects of an explosion and the steps required to protect personnel
- 2. Understand the differences between a mechanical and chemical explosion.
- 3. Identify and recognize, commercial explosives, military explosives, Detonators/blasting caps, homemade explosives/HME, and military ordnance.
- 4. Understand the construction of IED's, suicide bombers, VBIED's, and booby traps.

THE DINNER DETECTIVE


