08:00 a.m 10:00 a.m	PERIOD 1 - Rescue Task Force — Responding to Active Shooter Events Active shooter events continue to occur throughout our nation, and every jurisdiction has the potential to be the next location for such an event. Through critical review of past events, coupled with new understandings of the active shooter and causes of loss of life, a new way of responding to these incidents was developed. The first part of the response will be and aggressive search for the shooter, with the intent to stop the shooting in whatever way possible. Coupled with this, and based on real time intelligence, Rescue Task Forces may be deployed. The Rescue Task Force is a group made up of law enforcement and medical personnel who provide early access, treatment, and extrication of victims who are still in areas of potential danger. This training will explain current active shooter response concepts, explain and practice law enforcement response, and provide opportunities to prepare for the activation and use of Rescue Task Forces. This kind of disaster requires the response of all law enforcement officers in the area, including reserve law officers. Learn how to help if this happens in your town tomorrow.
