GRETCHEN BROWN-WAECH

Gretchen is the Victim Rights & Human Trafficking Coordinator with the Iowa Attorney General's Crime Victims Assistance Division (CVAD). She was the founding director of Deaf Iowans Against Abuse, serving deaf survivors of domestic and sexual violence state-wide for 8 years. In her present role at CVAD, she collaborates with other statewide organizations to develop and implement best practices and policies for victims of human trafficking and other violent crimes. This includes conducting presentations to raise awareness among community members, as well as targeted training for medical, law enforcement, and victim service providers.

STEFFANI SIMBRIC

Steffani has advocated for victims of sexual assault and domestic violence for more than 18 years. Her career started at Cedar Valley Friends of the Family in Waverly, Iowa where she worked as the domestic violence shelter coordinator, transitional housing program manager, and assistant director of the agency. She then joined the Iowa State University Police Department as the Story County SART (Sexual Assault Response Team) Coordinator. In November 2017 Steffani joined the Iowa Law Enforcement Academy staff and is responsible for instructing and coordinating the academy's human trafficking training.

REX HAVENS

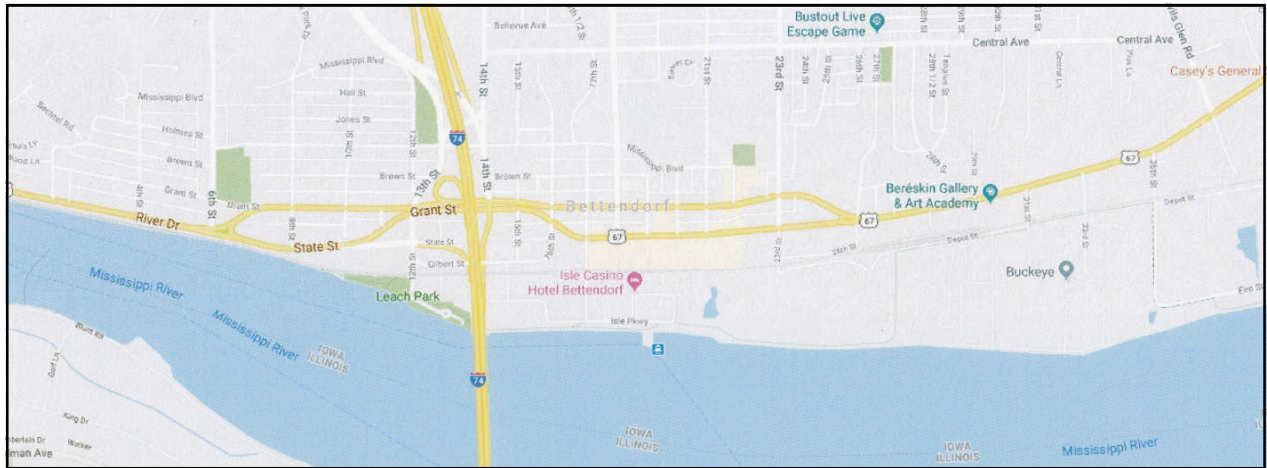
For 20 years, Rex Havens has entertained and educated audiences around the world with his insightful observations about the hilarious miscommunications that populate our personal lives.
