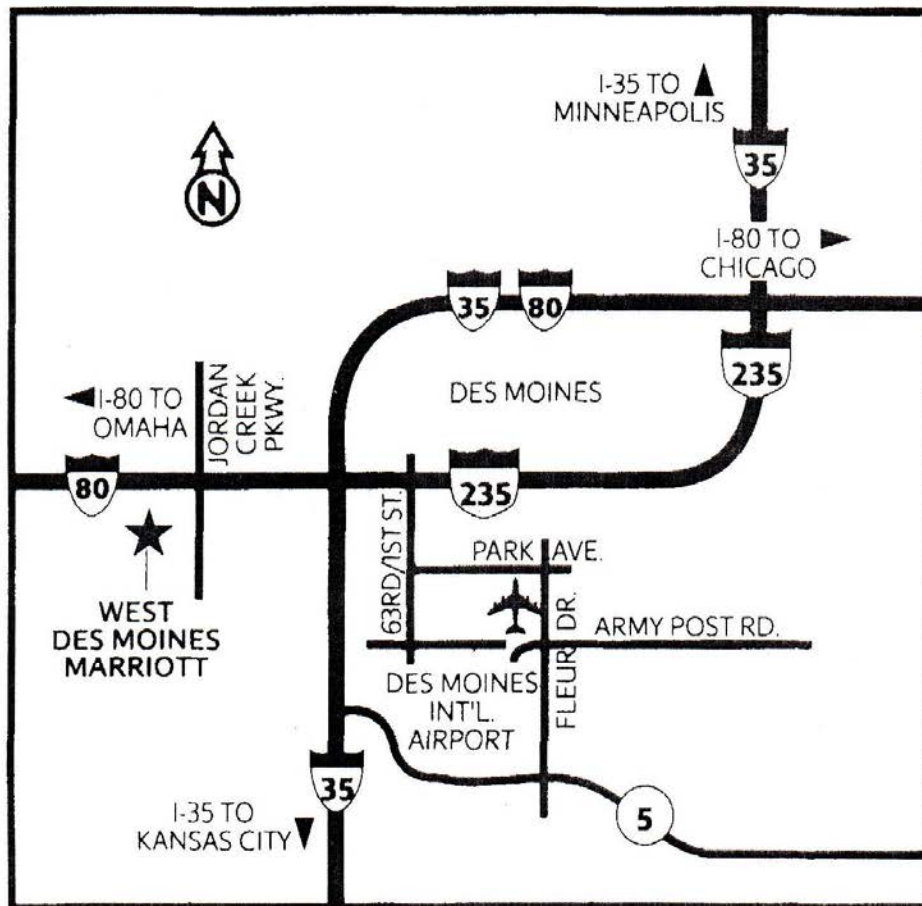
Audiences are treated to observations of rural life, tales of being a small town Mayor, songs and impressions, and plenty of stories about his wise-cracking Dad.
