TRAUMA RETALIATED INJURIES

Dr. Garrett Feddersen is the Emergency Room and EMS medical Director for the Buena Vista County Hospital and the field medic for the Buena Vista County Sheriff's Office and the Storm Lake Police Department.

Matt Imming has been in EMS since 1994 and has been a paramedic since 1997. He also serves as the FR-CARP Grant Coordinator for Webster County Public Health and covers all of Service Area 7. Matt is an instructor in many EMS related courses and has taught throughout Iowa as well as occasionally at ILEA.

They will talk about TRAUMA RETALIATED INJURIES and the best way to deal with them out in the field before EMS arrives. Toward the end of the class they will have a hands on demonstration of how to stop severe bleeding.

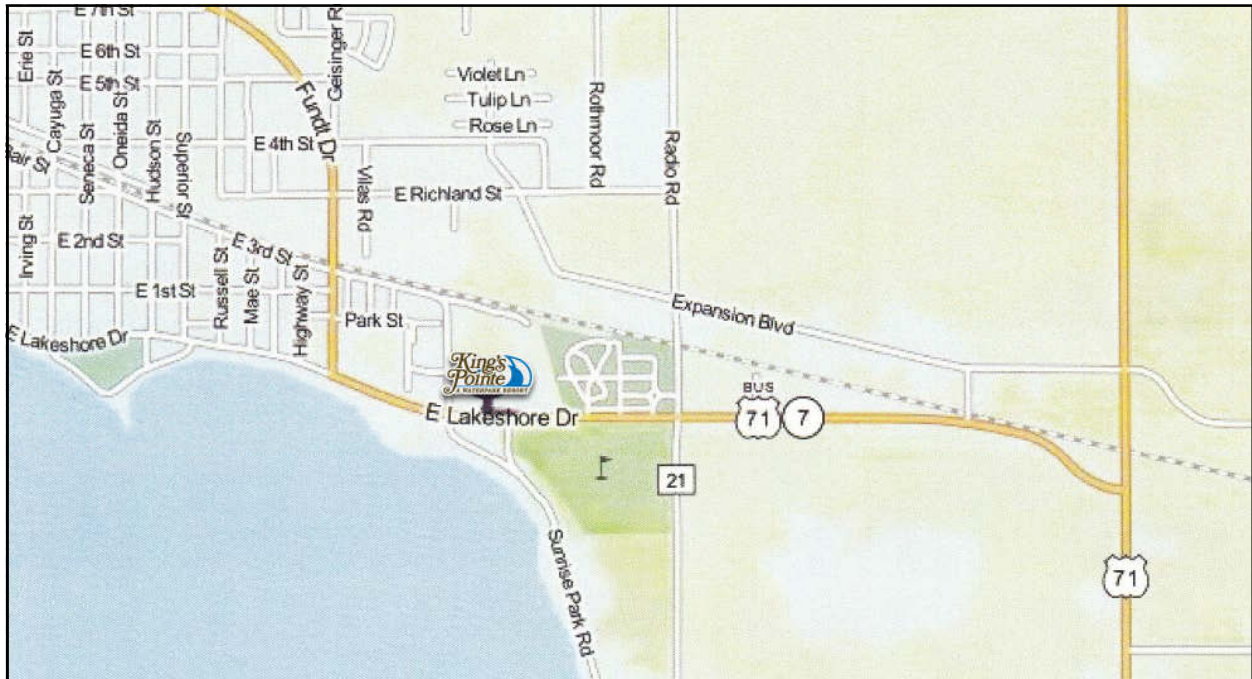
