

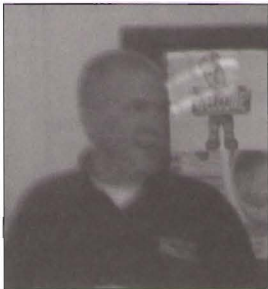
23rd Annual ILEA-ISRLOA Training Seminar

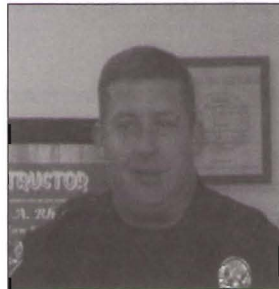

The instructors were: Dr Steve Rhoads and the seminar was presented through the Midwest Counterdrug Training Center located at Camp Dodge, Iowa.

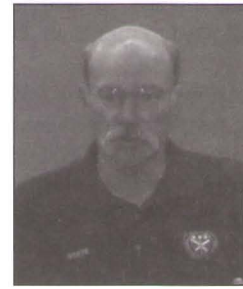

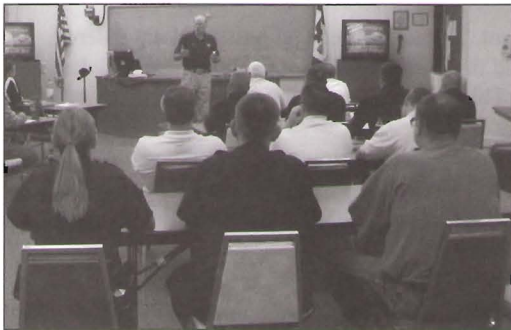

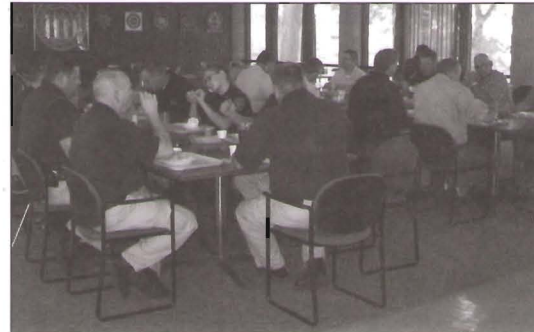
Training chairperson Brad Thomas introduces the instructor.
